RADAC DAY TICKET RULES

- Your day ticket entitles you to fish the Village Stretch only. The upstream limit is marked by a concrete 'tush' at the top of the allotments; the downstream by rocks before the farm.
- Your day ticket entitles you to fish only on the day you nominate. Anglers wishing to fish through the night i.e. past midnight must purchase additional tickets.
- Anglers fishing the Village Stretch overnight must avoid excessive noise or other behaviours likely to cause annoyance to nearby residents. Failure to do so may prevent future night fishing.
- All legitimate baits and styles of angling are permitted except that no prawn or shrimp baits may be used.
- You may fish with no more than two rods at any one time (no matter how many licences you hold).
- The use of 'lead core' leaders is prohibited.
- Barbel and carp may not be kept in keep nets.
- No coarse fish may be killed or otherwise taken away from the water.
- A maximum of two Brown Trout or Sea Trout may be killed in each visit.
- Anglers, especially fly fishermen, must be alert to people using the Village front behind them for recreation.
- On demand the holder of a day ticket must produce it, and his EA licence, when requested by an EA bailiff or RADAC member.
