


Ribchester Village Front Visitor Tickets

Ribchester and District Angling Club offers visitor ticket fishing on approximately 350 meters of the River Ribble at Ribchester (known as the Village Stretch). The stretch provides good fishing for coarse and game species with barbel, chub and pike being regularly caught by the coarse angler and sea trout by the game angler.



The upstream limit is marked by a concrete 'tush' at the top of the allotments; the downstream by rocks upstream of the farm and approximately in line with St Wilfrid's Church.

Day tickets are priced as follows:

- £8 per day for adult coarse fishing;
- £12 a day for adult game fishing;
- 50 pence for juniors under 14 (coarse and non-migratory trout).

Tickets are only sold at the SPAR shop in the Village. They must be bought in advance of fishing as they are not sold 'on the bank'. SPAR would wish you to purchase your tickets with cash only.

A day ticket runs from midnight to midnight. Anglers may purchase tickets for two days and therefore fish through the night.

As this stretch is in the middle of the Village anglers are requested to avoid excessive noise or other behaviours likely to cause annoyance to residents. In particular please be <u>very</u> careful to remove all litter and <u>especially</u> line and hooks.

You may fish with no more that two rods at any one time (no matter how many licences you hold).

The use of 'lead core' leaders is prohibited.

Barbel and carp may not be kept in keep nets.

No coarse fish may be killed or otherwise taken away from the water.

A maximum of two trout or sea trout may be killed in each visit.
